

## SPANISH ABROAD SUMMER SCHOLARSHIP

The Spanish Abroad Summer Scholarship (SASS) awards \$1,000 to one (1) Broward College student participating in the College Consortium for International Studies (CCIS) – [International College of Seville summer program](#).

### ELIGIBILITY

To be considered for the scholarship, at the time of application a student must:

- Be a degree-seeking student at Broward College. Students graduating on the spring term prior to the Spanish Summer program are not eligible to apply.
- Be 18 years of age or older at the time of departure.
- Show proof of a 3.0 cumulative GPA or higher.
- Have completed twelve (12) credit hours in 1000 and/or 2000 level courses at Broward College at the time of the application. One of the courses must be ENC 1101 with a minimum final course grade of C or better.
- Not be on academic or disciplinary probation.
- Be in possession of a passport which has a validity lasting at least six to nine months *after* the program end date. *If you are not a U.S. citizen, it is your responsibility to verify your legal status to travel outside of the United States. Broward College does not verify, obtain, nor guarantee applicants permission to travel outside the U.S. nor guarantee entry into any country.*
- Not have been a former recipient of the Spanish Abroad Summer Scholarship. Previous applicants who did not receive the scholarship, however, ARE eligible to reapply for full consideration.

*\*Please note, the scholarship does not require that applicants be a Florida resident, U.S. citizen, or full-time student in order to apply. All degree-seeking Broward students who meet the above criteria are eligible.*

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Spanish Abroad Summer Scholarship (SASS) is administered by the International Education Advisory Committee. Applications are to be submitted to the Greene International Education Institute by the application deadline as indicated below. Applications are then reviewed by and the recipient is chosen by majority vote.
2. Student selection criteria are based on individual student merit and their potential for returning the greatest benefit to BC upon completion of the summer abroad. The committee will evaluate applicants based on the following criteria:

- a. Merit and need of the student
  - b. Quality of essay (guidelines below)
  - c. Quality of recommendations on behalf of the student.
3. Students who are funded by the SAS Scholarship are expected to attend the International College of Seville. Students must maintain a good academic and disciplinary standing throughout the duration of the program.
  4. The scholarship amount, \$1,000.00, will be applied to the program cost and deducted from the program fees.
  5. Students who are selected for the SAS Scholarship are required to return to the college and participate in a minimum of two of the following activities in the subsequent term:
    - a. Deliver a presentation to a student organization, club, or class reflecting on their personal and academic growth as a result of this study abroad opportunity.
    - b. Write an article reflecting on their personal and academic growth because of this experience
    - c. Volunteer to donate a minimum of 20 hours to a BC office or department to be approved by the Study Abroad Office.
    - d. Attend at least one Study Abroad Information Session event to speak to other students about the benefits of this experience.
  6. The SAS Scholarship is not connected to federal Financial Aid. It is the student's responsibility to consult with the Financial Aid Office or other agencies if the scholarship affects or conflicts with current or future aid.
  7. Students are responsible for paying any remaining program fees in full before program start date.
  8. The William E. Greene Institute for International Education reserves the right to cancel the scholarship or seek repayment of funds if I withdraw from the program; I am expelled from the program or fail to meet the aforementioned obligations upon my return.

## APPLICATION MATERIALS

**A complete application packet will include the following:**

1. A signed Spanish Abroad Summer (SAS) Scholarship Application.
2. An unofficial Broward College transcript.
3. Two letters of recommendation from Broward professors. These letters must be typed on Broward College letterhead and signed by the FULL-TIME FACULTY or ADJUNCT PROFESSOR writing them.
4. A 700 - 1000 (minimum-maximum)-word typed essay about how participation in the International College of Seville Intensive Spanish summer program will impact the student's academic, professional and personal goals. Students should also describe why they are worthy of receiving the scholarship whether by need or merit. Students can include motivations, on-campus/community involvement, or even personal challenges or special circumstances.

## APPLICATION DEADLINE

Completed applications for the WEG Scholarship should be submitted by the following deadlines\*:
