Broward Community College (BCC), Fort Lauderdale, Florida and The College of Staten Island of the City University of New York (CSI), Staten Island, New York hereby enter into the following articulation agreement which provides for the orderly transfer of students from BCC to CSI.

1. GENERAL PROVISIONS:

- A. This agreement shall become effective on _____ and shall remain in effect until cancelled by either party. Six months notification will be required for cancellation.
- B. This agreement governs students enrolled in BCC's two-year university parallel programs in Florida and at BCC's international affiliates.

2. During the period of this agreement, CSI will:

- A. Accept BCC students who apply as transfer students when they meet established transfer requirements. Students must meet all regular requirements for admission to CSI, including requirements for foreign students (when applicable).
- B. Accept credits earned in college level courses with a grade of "C" or better from BCC or its international affiliates.
- C. Provide students who apply with a course-by-course transfer evaluation and inform students of any requirements still to be satisfied.
- D. Provide BCC on a regular basis with current catalogs, application materials, and information on requirements for transfer and admission.

3. During the period of this agreement, BCC will:

- A. Publicize this agreement and the opportunities to transfer among students, faculty, and staff in Florida and at international affiliates.

- B. Inform all international affiliates of this agreement and its terms and conditions.
- C. Provide CSI with current information regarding BCC's international affiliates.
- D. Provide assistance to transfer students to facilitate the accurate and timely submission of admission applications and other necessary documentation.

4. CONDITIONS:

- A. Admission to CSI does not automatically constitute admission to a specific academic program. Transfer students must meet all requirements and satisfy all prerequisites for specific academic programs. BCC is to be notified when admission to limited access programs is restricted.
- B. Both institutions will monitor the academic performance of BCC transfer students and work cooperatively to minimize transfer and matriculation problems.
